NEW CHAIRMAN AND BOARD MEMBER APPOINTED

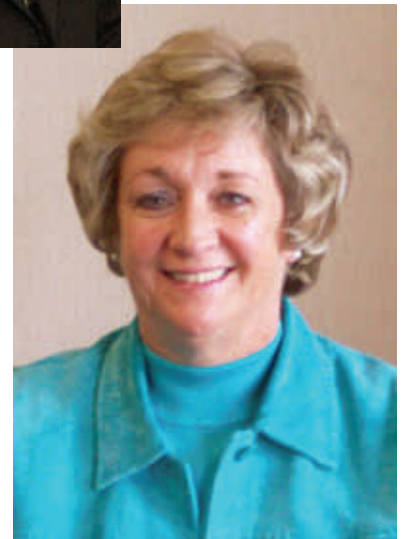
The Wyoming Stock Growers Agricultural Land Trust made some significant changes during its Board Meeting on June 4 in conjunction with the Wyoming Cattle Industry Convention & Trade Show in Gillette. The Board appointed Randall Luthi of Freedom as Chairman of the Board, replacing Mark Eisele and welcomed Dianne Kirkbride of Cheyenne to the Board of Directors.

Randall Luthi is an attorney and rancher from Northwestern Lincoln County. He is a partner in the Luthi and Voyles law firm in Thayne and a managing partner of the JE Luthi Ranch, located in Lincoln County. Luthi served as a Republican for the Wyoming Legislature from 1995 to 2007 where he served as Speaker of the House of Representatives. He has just returned to the Cowboy State from Washington DC where he served as Deputy Director of the United States Fish and Wildlife Service and Director of the Minerals Management Service.
